Enclosed you will find a complete set of the Federal Program/Grant Concordance prepared by the Guam State Clearinghouse and presented on April 21, 2008, to the Chairs of the Civilian Military Task Force Subcommittees. The concordance serves as a basic reference index for all federal grant/program opportunities available to Guam. This management tool allows users to identify programs that meet specific objectives of the potential applicant, and to obtain general information on Federal assistance programs. In addition, the concordance attempts to improve coordination and communication between the Federal government and the government of Guam relating to potential federal program and grant opportunities.

The Federal Program/Grant Concordance is a valuable resource tool that, if used carefully, can make it easier for agencies to identify specific areas of program interest more efficiently. Program information may be cross referenced within each of the following Federal Program Concordances:

1. Program/grant opportunities (*Chronological Listing of Grant Opportunities and Program Eligibility* – two volumes);
2. Applicant eligibility (*Chronological Listing of Program Eligibility* – three separate stand-alone and independent volumes);
3. Functional classification (*Functional Index* – two volumes); and,
4. Program opportunity profiling and a chronicle of Guam's grant awards/applications (*Complete Grant Opportunity Profile and Government of Guam Awarded Programs/Grants*).
