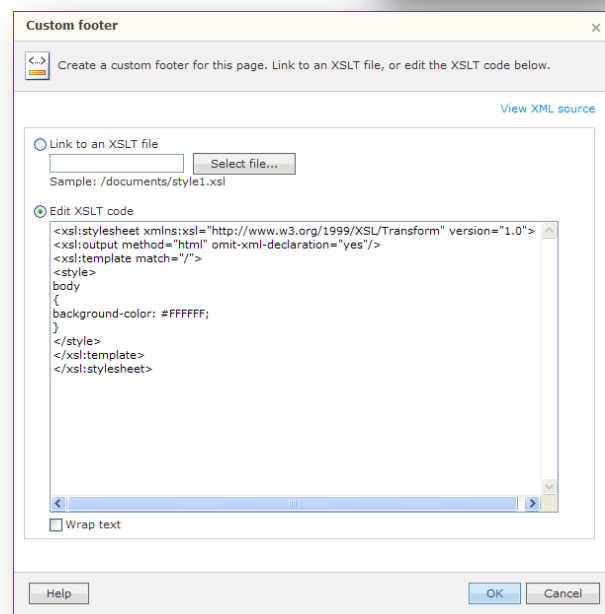
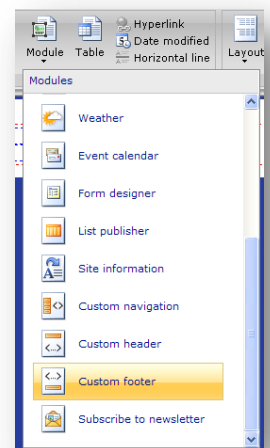
Making a Navigation Link open in a New Window

1. First create a blank page, name it anything you wish. And display it on the navigation, and uncheck to display, header, navigation, and footer.
2. Add a custom footer module to the page and replace everything in the Custom Footer module with the code below, this will make the page, which will make it more transparent to the visitor:

  <xsl:output method="html" omit-xml-declaration="yes"/>
  <xsl:template match="/">
    <style>
      body
      {
        background-color: #FFFFFF;
      }
    </style>
  </xsl:template>
</xsl:stylesheet>
```

3. Next create another Custom Footer module and paste the following code into it, this will redirect the page to your desired location, replace "mydomain.com" in both locations in the code. This code also includes a noscript tag in case the visitor does not have JavaScript enabled.

  <xsl:output method="html" omit-xml-declaration="yes"/>
  <xsl:template match="/">
    <script type="text/javascript">
      window.location.replace('http://domain.com');
    </script>
    <noscript>
      <p>
        <a href="http://domain.com" target="blank">Click Here</a> to continue.
      </p>
    </noscript>
  </xsl:template>
</xsl:stylesheet>

4. Next, on every page of your site you will need to use the following code to open the navigation link in a new window. Choose the appropriate code for the type of navigation you have, either top or left. The code should be in a HTML module. To determine which linked needs to be opened in a new window, count the number of links and subtract one. For example if the link is number 7 subtract 1 and change the codes link number to 6 (highlighted).

For Top Navigation:

```

<script type="text/javascript">
var p = parent.document;
var link = p.getElementById('IWS_WH_Elem_TopNav').getElementsByTagName('a');
var target_links = [link[0]];
for (var l = 0; l < target_links.length; l++){
target_links[l].target = '_blank';
}
</script>

```

For Left Navigation:

```

<script type="text/javascript">
var p = parent.document;
var link = p.getElementById('IWS_WH_Elem_LeftNav').getElementsByTagName('a');
var target_links = [link[0]];
for (var l = 0; l < target_links.length; l++){
target_links[l].target = '_blank';
}
</script>

```
